Dear comrades,

We are writing to all of you to express our sincere gratitude for your participation in the Global Progressive Mobilisation, recently held in Barcelona. Your commitment and presence made possible a gathering which, we are convinced, will mark a turning point in cooperation among progressive forces at the global level.

During those days, Barcelona became more than merely the host city of a major event. It stood as a beacon—a space for dialogue, for thoughtful and sincere debate, and for shared conviction. It was also a setting in which we renewed the hope and determination of progressives around the world, who look to Spain with confidence and as a model to follow.
